Biographical Note

Milton Wheaton Hamilton was born July 8, 1901, in Fabius, New York and died February 26, 1989. He received his bachelor's and master's degrees from Syracuse University in 1924 and 1925, respectively, and his Ph.D. in history from Columbia University in 1936. In that year, Columbia University Press published his dissertation, *The Country Printer, New York State, 1785-1830*.

Milton was professor of history at Albright College, Reading, PA from 1926 to 1949. During this period, he also edited the scholarly journal, *Pennsylvania History*, from 1944 to 1950.

From 1949 until his retirement in 1965, Milton held the position of Senior Historian in the Division of Archives and History of the New York State Education Department. He was Acting Director of the division from 1963 to 1965. It was during his employment with the division that Milton established his reputation as a specialist on the life of Sir William Johnson (1715-1774), the famous landowner, military leader, and Indian negotiator of colonial New York.

Milton was editor of *The Papers of Sir William Johnson*. It was under his editorship that the New York State Education Department published the final four volumes of the series that had begun in 1921: Vol. X (1951), Vol. XI (1953), Vol. XII (1957), and Vol. XIII (1962). Milton also supervised preparation of the comprehensive index to the Papers published in 1965 as Vol. XIV.

Sir William Johnson Colonial American, 1715-1763 (Kennikat Press), the first volume of Milton's two-volume biography of Sir William Johnson was published in 1976. The second volume was never published.

Milton wrote numerous reviews and articles on historical subjects and historiography.

Scope and Content Note

The Milton Hamilton Papers spans the period from 1911-1987, with the bulk of the material [dates] and contains documents relating to his professional life, with some personal correspondence. The collection is divided into four series: Correspondence Files; Writings; Research Materials; and Miscellaneous. The material was donated by Mrs. William Y. Stevens, Milton Hamilton's daughter, in 1993 and in 1994. The arrangement of the material retains the original order in which Milton Hamilton kept his files. Missing from the collection are any financial records.

The Library also holds the Milton W. Hamilton Printing Collection (HU 81-17) which concerns the history of printing in America, and includes correspondence and research notes on *The Country Printer* and *Adam Ramage and His Presses*, photographs, pamphlets, newspaper clippings. In addition, the Institute owns Hamilton's private library of 200 bound volumes and 100 pamphlets on the history of printing.

The Library also holds the Johnson Family Papers, collection GY 78-32, donated by Milton W. Hamilton.
